

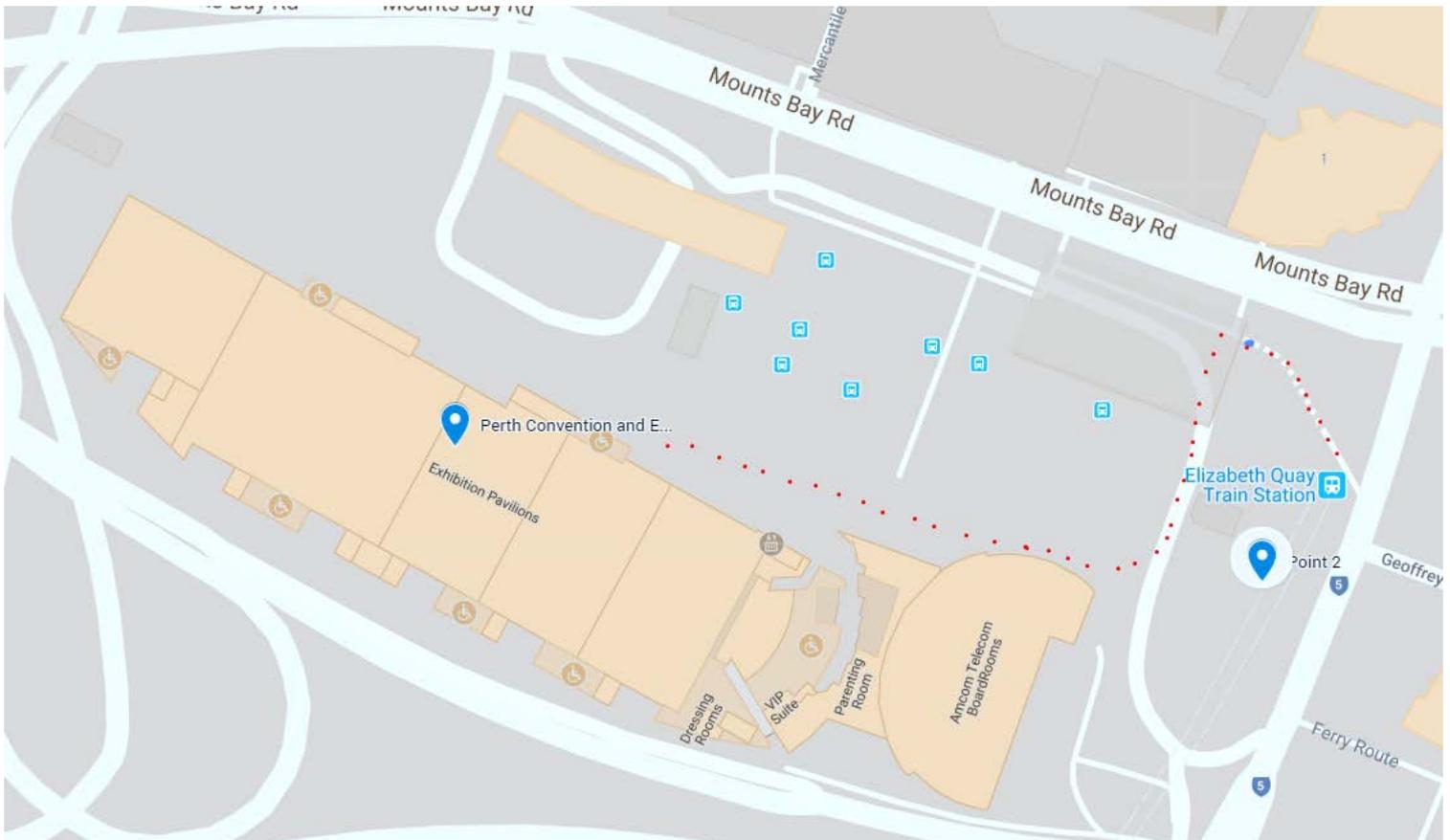
1. Location of Venue

The Conference is being held at the Perth Convention and Exhibition Centre (PCEC), which is located adjacent to the Elizabeth Quay precinct. The closest train station to PCEC is Elizabeth Quay Station which is only a few minutes' walk from the centre. The Elizabeth Quay Bus Station is also close by.

2. Airport and Transport

AIRPORT



Perth Airport is located 13 kilometres from Perth's City Centre, approximately a 20 minute drive. The following transport options are available.

BUS

TAXI



A taxi trip from the airport terminals to Perth will take 20 mins depending on the time of day. The journey will cost approximately A\$30.00 – A\$50.00. All taxis are meter operated by time and distance and operate twenty-four hours a day. Taxis indicate they are vacant by illuminating their sign on the roof. Taxis are easily accessible from the airport; there are ranks outside both the international and domestic terminals. Please add information re: how to order a wheelchair accessible taxi here. UBER



An Uber is approximately A\$25-35.00 from the Airport to Perth's City Centre. Please note your pickup location depends on your terminal and ride option.

Follow the below steps if you would like to utilise an Uber service:

1. Download the [Uber](#) App on your mobile device by searching 'Uber' in iTunes or Google Play.
2. Create an account and enter your details as directed.
3. Please wait until you have collected your luggage and are ready to leave the airport before requesting your ride using the Uber app.
4. Exit the terminal - The pickup location will depend on the type of vehicle you have selected. Please refer to the instructions below to find out where to meet your driver.
5. Look for your vehicle and driver – if you can't find your driver, contact them through the app.

Rideshares:

There are dedicated rideshare pick-up bays within easy walking distance of each terminal. Simply follow the directions on the terminal signage to the nearest rideshare pick-up bay. [Click here](#) to view the location on a map.

3. Parking



There are approximately 5,000 car parking bays within a 10-minute walk of Perth Convention and Exhibition Centre. Below are the closest options:

CPP Convention Centre	1 min walk (located directly under PCEC)
Westralia Square	4 min walk (Entry height 2.1m)
The Forrest Centre	4 min walk (Entry height 2.05m)
The Quadrant	4 min walk (Entry height 2.1m)
40 The Esplanade	4 min walk (Entry height 1.95m)
CCP Terrace Road	10-15 min walk (Open air car park no height restrictions)

There are 23 Disability Parking Bays in the Perth Convention and Exhibition car park.

It is best to park in the eastern end of the car park as this will allow quicker access the lift, that will bring you up to Level 2.

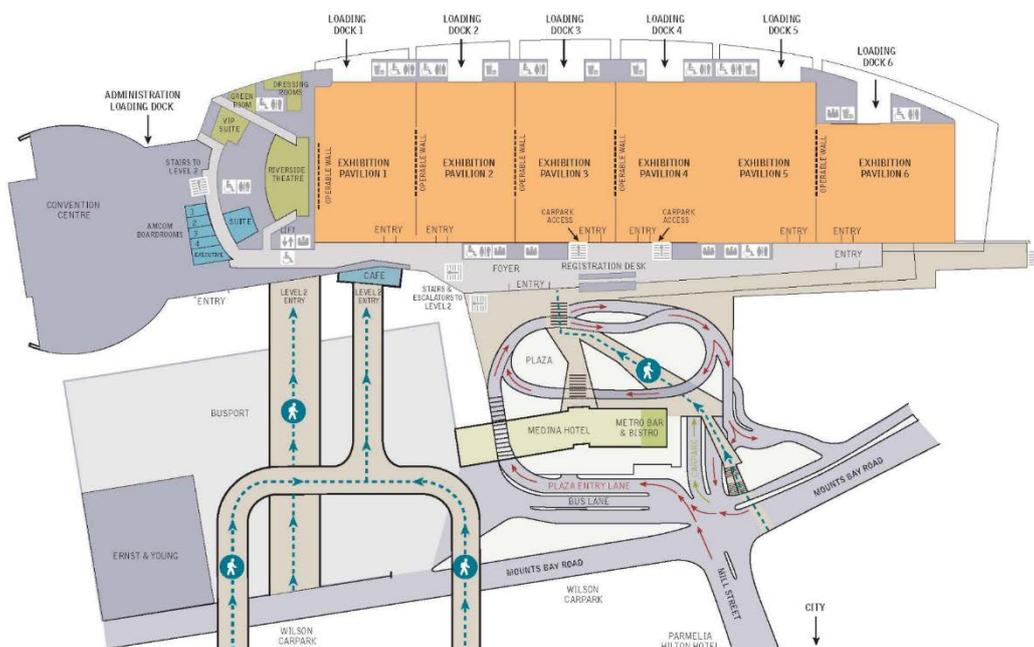
Please note there is a maximum height of 2.10m which may be too low for some large vans to access

The Plaza Level of the Perth Convention and Exhibition Centre has a drop off only zone. (As indicated on the map by red arrows). There is a lift at this drop off zone that will take you to Level 2.

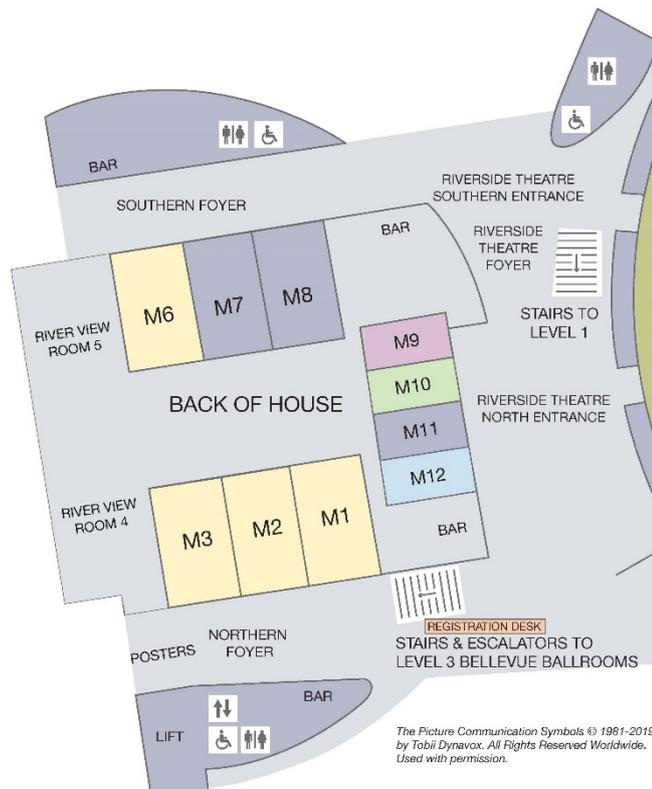
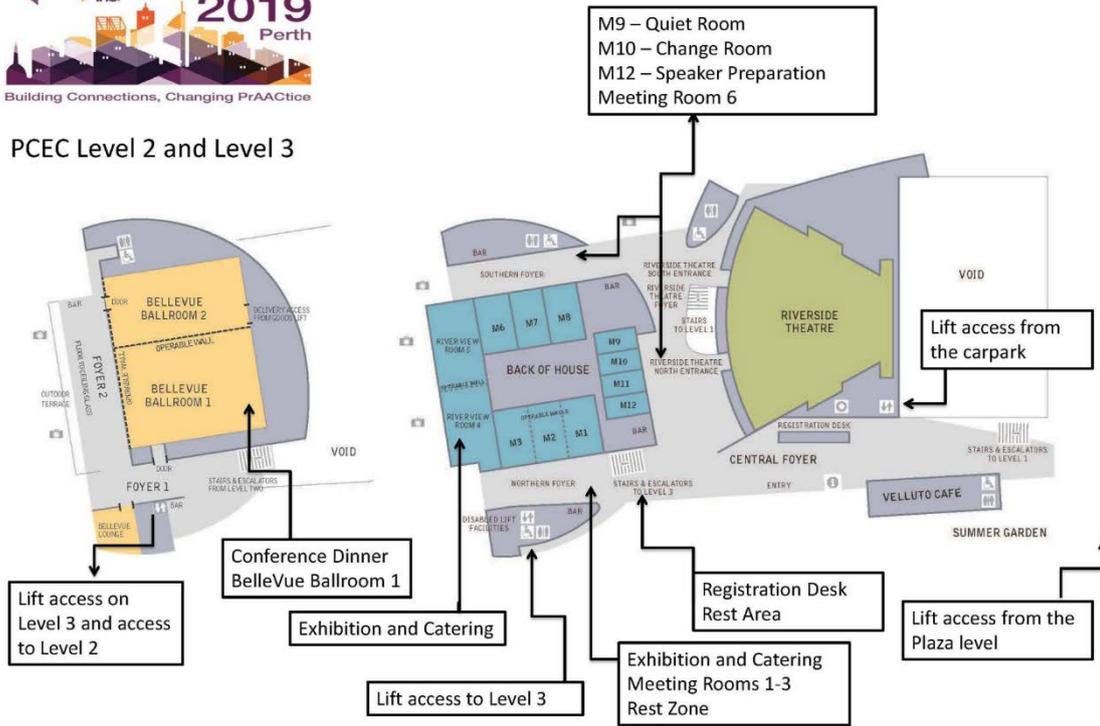
Public transport is the most effective and inexpensive way to access the venue via train and bus.

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Change Room:

The change room is located in Meeting Room 10 of the Perth Convention and Exhibition Centre. Hoists and changing tables are available in the Change Room.

Quiet Room:

A quiet room with relaxation spaces and private areas without distractions will be available throughout the conference in Meeting Room M9. This area will be equipped with foam mats to lie down on, quiet areas and comfortable spaces to spend time away from noise, lights and other stimuli.

5. Checking into your Hotel

For most hotels the check-in time is 1500 hours. Your hotel will do their best to have rooms available for early check-in. However, if you wish to confirm your room for an early arrival, you will need to pre-book and pay for the room from the previous evening.

As per standard hotel policies and procedures, delegates will be required to provide a credit card or a cash bond upon check in. This is to cover any incidental charges incurred during your stay regardless as to whether your accommodation has been pre-paid in full. The hotel will place a hold on your credit card or hold the cash deposit until you check-out. Should you not utilise any incidentals during your stay the credit card will not be charged and/or the cash deposit will be returned. Please note the daily incidental charge rates will vary across hotels. Should you wish to confirm the required amount for incidental charges prior to check-in, please contact the hotel directly.

6. Registration Process

The registration desk will be located Northern Foyer of the Perth Convention and Exhibition Centre on Level 2. All participants must visit the registration desk to collect their Conference materials and name badge before gaining access to the Conference.
