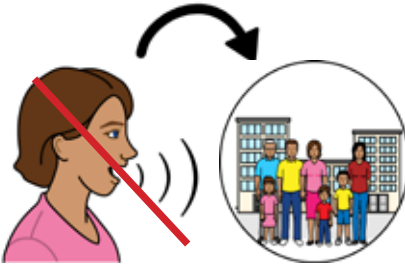

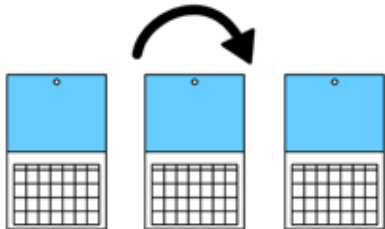


About this book

Complex communication needs means it is very hard for someone to

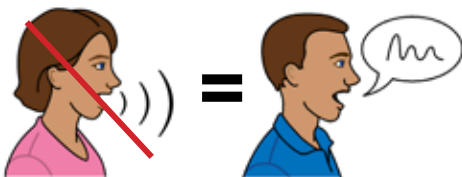
- speak

Communication rights means people who have **no** speech have the same rights as people who have speech.

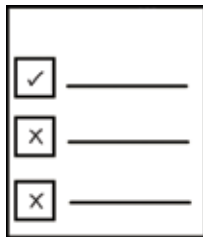
Jaquie has 2 sons with disability.
